

THE GIRL IN THE VIDEO

When a private video from a house party is posted online without her consent, a bright young woman on the brink of university finds her future abruptly contaminated by public shame. What begins as a moment of personal violation quickly becomes something far more dangerous: a social unravelling in which friendship, loyalty, and reputation are weaponised against her. As gossip spreads through her school, home, and wider community, she realises the deepest wound is not the video itself, but the growing suspicion that the people closest to her knew more than they ever admitted.

With trust collapsing around her, she is drawn towards the one person who seems genuinely disturbed by what has happened: a quiet, emotionally guarded young man whose connection to the guilty circle makes him both comfort and risk. As attraction deepens and the truth begins to shift beneath her, humiliation gives way to resolve. The series unfolds as a tense, emotionally charged drama about exposure, complicity, first love, and the cost of reclaiming your own story once other people have turned it into spectacle.
